<u>Christmas Mass Arrangements.</u> Given our current Covid situation, our Bishops have issued some guidelines about Christmas Masses this year. The first is that the present rules of social distancing and wearing face coverings still apply. In addition the Government's prohibition on singing inside a place of worship continues (so, obviously, for this year there will not be sung Carols at any Mass, although we will have instrumental accompaniment). Also, since other locations have to close by 11.00pm, this should be borne in mind in working out the timing of "Midnight Mass". Lastly, the Bishops point out that since Christmas has an Octave, then Masses after Christmas Eve and Christmas Day can also be counted as a celebration of Christmas so that (despite the obvious attachment to 24<sup>th</sup>/25<sup>th</sup> December) people are free to choose another day to have their religious celebration of Our Lord's Nativity.

As a result, the arrangements I am proposing for this year are: Christmas Eve - Mass at 6.00pm and 10.00pm. Christmas Day - Mass at 9.00am and 11.00am. Saturday 26<sup>th -</sup> Mass at 10.00am and 6.00pm. Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> - Mass at 9.00am and 11.00am. Monday 28<sup>th</sup> - Mass at 10.00am. Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> Mass - at 9.30am. Each of these will have the prayers and readings of Christmas.

Booking will be needed for each of these Masses and booking opens on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December. Thank you for your understanding in these difficult times.
