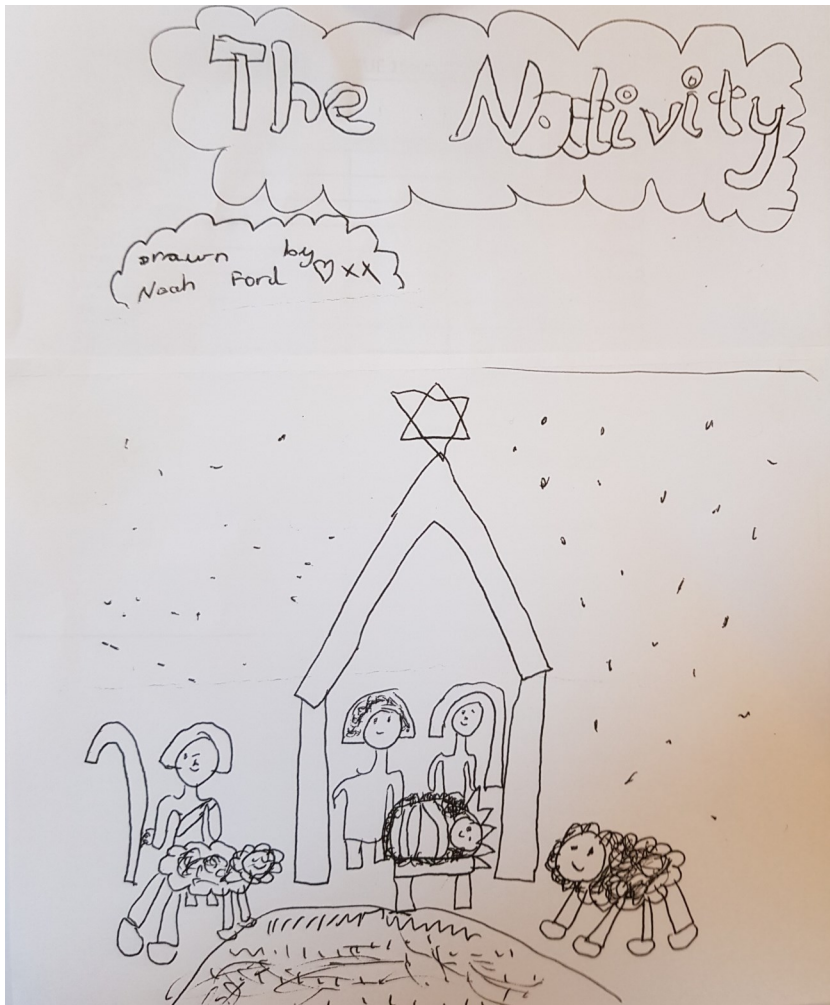
100 CLUB DRAW: The draw for December will take place on Tuesday 5th January. Good luck!
