

**COVID ROADMAP AND CHURCHES**: We are all aware that some restrictions on daily life were lifted on 17th May. But, as I stressed at Mass 2 weeks ago, the Government has not eased the restrictions which apply to attending Mass. In other words, social distancing and the wearing of face coverings remain compulsory. This means that, until we are told otherwise, because of the seating capacity of the church building, Booking Mass places at weekends is still essential. The cut-off time for booking is 12 noon each Friday. A new booking is required each week. Please note that we have reached the stage that if people turn up without a booking, then it is highly unlikely that a place will be available and we will then have to turn people away. This is something we have always been reluctant to do, but the current increase of people wanting to attend Mass may make this necessary. Could I also please invite your co-operation so that, if you have a booking, please arrive in good time before Mass begins so that we may know whether or not we have any spare capacity. I am afraid that late-comers cannot be guaranteed a place. Thank you for your support. Fr David.
