The envelopes for the new tax year are at the back of the Church.

Will the parishioners who are already in the scheme please collect them as soon as possible. If you are unable to get to the Church but still wish to continue to donate through the Gift Aid Scheme, then give Chris Dayer a call and we will get them to you.

Our Parish has just received a refund of £13011 from the Inland Revenue for the tax that our Gift Aiders have paid on their donations in the 2020/21 tax year. This refund is especially welcome this year as donations to our Parish are lower because of the COVID restrictions.

The Brentwood Catholic Children's Society is inviting parishioners across the Diocese to join in with their '**Relay 100**' summer community event. Shopping List June/July 2021

Thank you for your continuing support during the Coronavirus crisis.

It is with your fantastic support that we are pleased to only be in short supply of the below items. By continuing to support us, we are actively working towards a future where there is no longer a need for Foodbanks.

We currently need:

Food Items:

- Custard (packet variant please)
- Sugar (500g please)
- Squash (1l or under please)

Other Essentials:

- Toothbrushes (singles, multi and children's please)
- Deodorant (spray cans please)

Our food parcels are made up of specific food groups so that those in need have enough food for at least nine meals. **The list above shows what we are in need of as we currently have good stocks of pasta, pasta sauce, biscuits, rice, fish, soup, tinned meat, beans, baby food and cereals.**

We also ask for small packs of food as larger packs do not fit in our parcels, making it difficult for our clients to carry home.

However, we can only accept donations of freshly-bought, unopened and undamaged goods which are still well within their "use by" date (no less than 6 months). We cannot use items which do not meet these requirements, and the donation is wasted.

Commencement of the Parish group will of course be dependent on when the Diocese will allow us access to the Church hall.
