BOOKING FOR WEEKEND MASSES

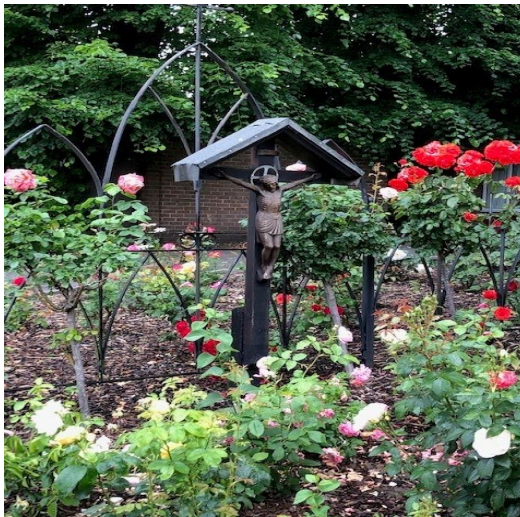

Dear First Holy Communion Parents

The FHC Catechist Team has pleasure in letting you know that we are finally in a position to be able to inform you when the final workshop for your child will be and in order to give you as much notice as possible, this date has been set for **Saturday 4th September 2021 (9 am - 11 am)**.
