October Youth Mass with One Hope Project - Thursday 7th October, Brentwood Cathedral

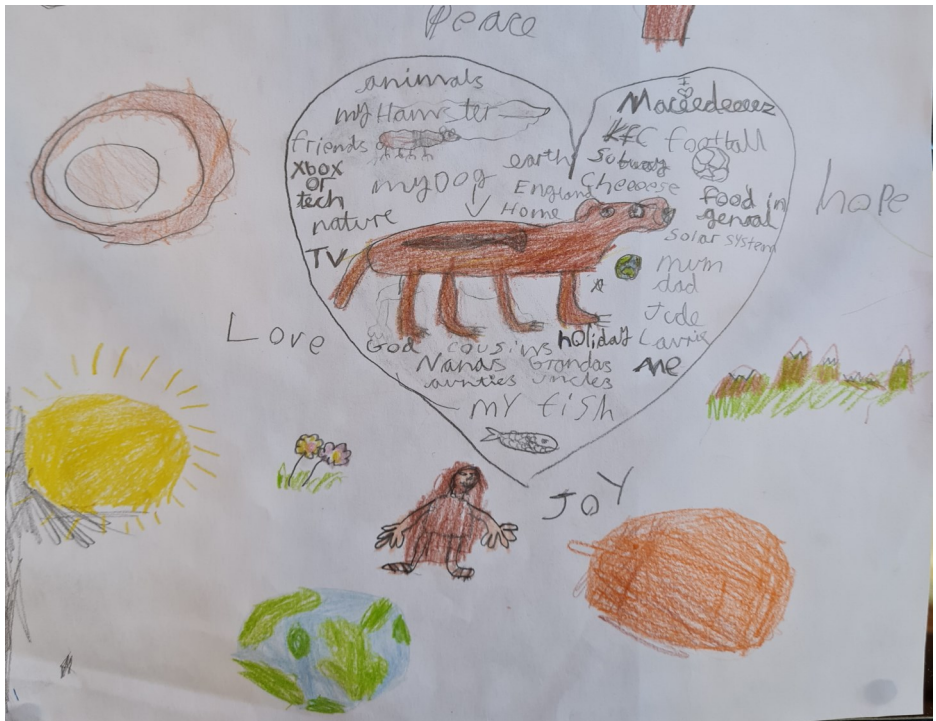
