#### ANGLIA SINGERS

The Anglia Singers (the choir of Anglia Ruskin University in Chelmsford) have been giving concerts in Our Lady Queen of Peace for many years. The musicians return to Braintree on Sunday 24 March with a concert starting at 4pm and lasting just over the hour. It is hoped that they will be conducted by Emeritus Professor Chris Green who will conduct for the first time in ten months following a very serious illness and an accident. During that time, he was awarded one of the highest music awards in the United Kingdom by Making Music, the charity that represents thousands of music organisations. The main work in the programme will be Fauré's beautiful Requiem, a reminder that 2024 marks the  $100^{\rm th}$  anniversary of Fauré's death. Other works by Fauré and Duruflé are in the programme which also includes the Coronation anthem written by Andrew Lloyd Webber for King Charles and Queen Camilla in 2023.

Tickets for the concert are now available costing £8 from the Presbytery or from Stationery Solutions in Fairfield Road, Braintree or at the door on the day. It is hoped that financial support from the concert will be given to the House of Grace project in Witham. Children aged 11 or under are admitted free of charge.
