

Parish Administrator- Our Lady of Good Counsel- Wickford: A vacancy has arisen for a Parish Administrator, to provide administrative support services to the Parish Office by implementing and maintaining office systems, processes and procedures and delivering a welcoming, appropriate service to those attending the parish office. Carrying out financial duties is also required as part of the role. All applicants should have good administrative and finance skills, although some training will be given. The post will be part-time working 12 hours per week – (4 Days per week, 3 hours per day). The salary is £12.60 per hour The closing date for applications is 6th August 2025 and suitable applicants will be invited to attend interviews week commencing 18th August 2025.

Church closed until Friday when the contractors finish. Saturday 23rd August. During the morning, the remaining benches to be brought from the Hall back into the Church. Parishioners help needed. Saturday 23rd /Sunday 24th August. Masses as usual.
