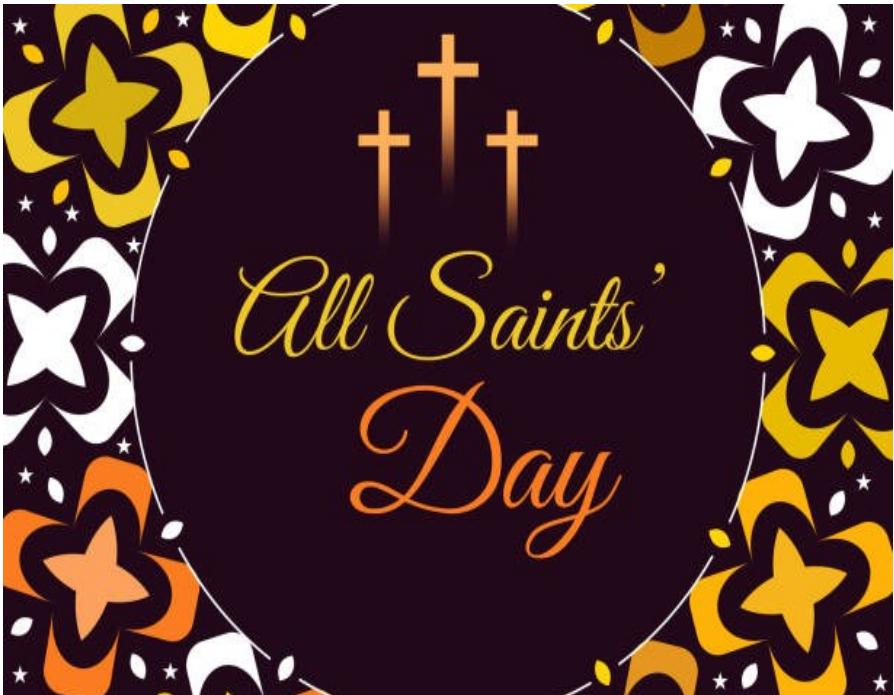

MASSES NEXT WEEKEND. In the Church Liturgical Calendar, 9th November is the Feast of the Lateran Basilica and this takes precedence over a Sunday in Ordinary time. As a result, at the 6pm Saturday Mass and the 9am Sunday Mass, the prayers and readings will be from the Feast. In this country, 9th November is also Remembrance Sunday and at the 11 o'clock Mass the Prayers will be for the fallen of the Two World Wars and later conflicts, and the Readings will be for the Feast. **Thank you. REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY. As noted above, Remembrance Sunday falls on the 9th November this year. Whilst there will be a general theme of remembrance at all Masses, at the 11.00am Mass in particular the Mass Prayers will be for the fallen of the Two World Wars. As in previous years, we will also start that Mass with the Two Minutes Silence. If you happen to arrive while that is taking place, you are kindly asked to respect the solemnity of that time. **Thank you. Fr David.**
