As we approach Christmas our readings are starting to take a seasonal turn to draw us into the beloved story of the Lord's coming among us. In the Gospel reading today we hear about Joseph's kind and gracious reaction to his betrothed's unexpected condition, and the angel who came to him in a dream to convince him that God had chosen him for something very special, the care of Mary and Jesus.

Now Joseph is a man of few words in Scripture, in fact, he never speaks at all! In more than one way then, he might be considered the perfect husband! But, as St Francis of Assisi reminded us, our actions in faith are just as important, if not more so, than our words, and when Joseph wakes, he immediately acts in response.

And that's Joseph's holiness, it's certainly not in grand oratory, but in his humility and faithful obedience to God. He changes his plans, he takes Mary into his home, he makes space for God's work, even when it completely upends his expectations.

So, as we make our final preparations for Christmas, Joseph invites us to reflect on how God speaks to us, often quietly, in ways that require trust rather than certainty. Like Joseph, we don't have all the answers and we may not fully understand what God is doing. But we are asked, again and again, to not be afraid and to respond with faith.

As this is my last reflection before the celebrations, I'd like to take the opportunity to wish all of you, and your families, a happy and holy Christmas and every blessing for the coming year.
