SATURDAY 19TH SEPTEMBER :

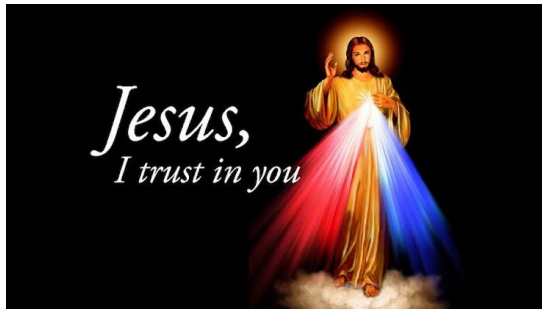
The SVP are holding a fundraising Quiz to support the ongoing works of the SVP.
